Our modern villas are smartly designed with a focus on low maintenance and comfortable living. This means you can spend less time on upkeep and more time doing the things you enjoy.







A commitment to sustainability

We're serious about using our resources wisely and taking into account the long-term impact of everything we do. Which is why all of our retirement villages focus on three distinct areas of sustainability: community development, designing for an ageing population and the sustainable use of natural resources.

Affinity Village embodies these attributes. In particular, the state of the art Clubhouse has been designed to meet the most stringent environmental standards, and is the first and only retirement living building in Australia to be awarded a prestigious 5 Star Green Star Public Building Design PILOT certified rating from the Green Building Council of Australia.

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Here are some of the initiatives that we used in our design, to achieve such a high standard.

MANAGEMENT

A computer-based management system automatically monitors where and how we use energy and water in the building. It means we can take steps to reduce usage and fine-tune the building's performance for the future.

2 WATER

We've carefully selected fittings and fixtures that ensure the most efficient use of water. Toilets are 4 star rated – using just 4.5 litres for full flush and 3 litres for half-flush

- and urinals are waterless. Most taps are 6 star rated, meaning they use just 4.5 litres a minute (compared to up to 9 litres per minute for 3 star rated alternatives).

3 INDOOR ENVIRONMENT QUALITY

Inside we've incorporated features that reduce our impact on the environment, while also creating a more comfortable and healthy space for our residents.

Sensors inside the air conditioning continually monitor the quality of air, and adjust the amount of fresh air pumped into the building. Windows and skylights have been cleverly designed to allow in ample natural light. And Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) in the carpets, paint and furniture, reduce the release of toxins into the indoor environment.



4 ENERGY EFFICIENCY

Extra insulation in the walls and ceilings as well as high performance glazing means the Clubhouse retains heat in winter and stays cooler in summer.

The use of natural light, orientation, highly efficient light fittings and metering and motion sensors helps us to use only the lighting energy we need. In fact, the Clubhouse design uses 62 per cent less lighting energy, when compared with a standard building of a similar size.

5 MATERIALS

Insulation to the roof and thermal mass to the walls contribute to the temperature control of the building,


keeping it warmer in winter and cooler in summer.

The waste storage area has been specifically designed to cater for recycle bins and provide equal access to recycling. This will help the community cut down on the waste foot print.

6 TRANSPORT

Cycling is not only good for your health, it helps reduce greenhouse gas emissions, congestion and noise pollution too. That's why we've incorporated facilities like bike racks, showers and storage lockers, to enable staff and visitors to cycle to and from the Clubhouse.

- No steps to enter the house or shower

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

While each of our villages is unique, they're all based on our intimate understanding of what makes retirement communities work.


