With the Mulligan Highway complete and sealed access through out most of the Cape, as well as NBN Optic fiber in Cooktown the tyranny of distance is over. Be part of Cooktowns future growth from a prime waterfront position.

Cook Shire Council are well underway with the Esplanade upgrade. The Waterfront activity precinct now complete, the next section including to the new boat ramp is to be completed before the 2021 Cooktown Expo celebrating 251 years since the arrival of Captain Cook and his crew in 1770.



Location

Cooktown the tropical gateway to Cape York attracts thousands of domestic and international visitors each year, with the Grassy Hill Lookout being a must-see attraction. Nestled into the base of Grassy Hill and a 500 metre stroll to the town centre. Pristine beaches, tropical lagoons, waterfalls, and outstanding fishing await,

Highlights

Easy to manage in excellent condition with strong year round occupancy. This has been maintained throughout the pandemic. Current return on investment 11%. Potential to turn upstairs into two separate self contained units for short term letting enabling high rental returns seasonally or year round. Potential to install a pontoon out the front for single vessel holding similar to neighbours on both sides. This extension would potentially attract a marine operator to operate out of the building.

High foot traffic zone as all cruise ship arrivals tender from the main wharf. Most road tourists make their way to the waterfront numerous times on their visit to Cooktown.

Cooktown receives around 80% of all tourists travelling on Cape York. The current hospital is about to be enlarged to become the medical service centre of Cape York for hospital needs reducing the current load on Cairns Base Hospital. 200 extra staff planned for this facility



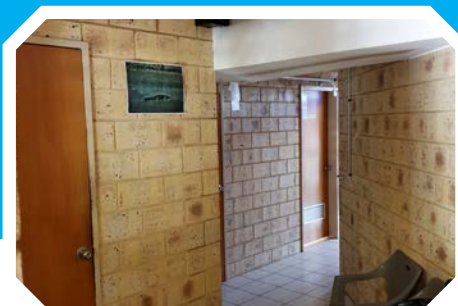
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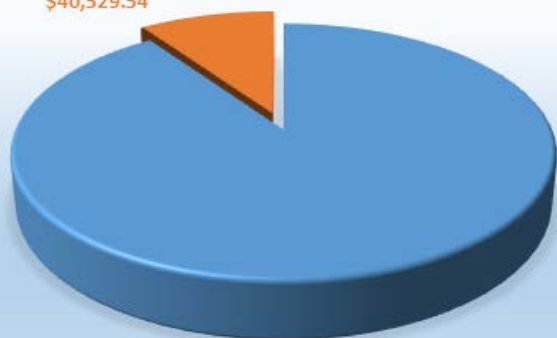
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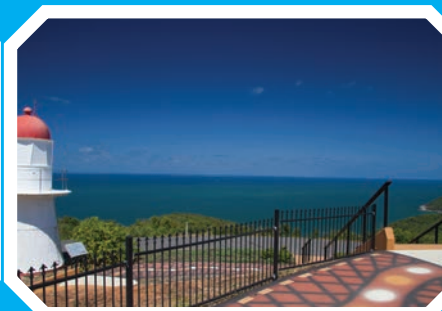
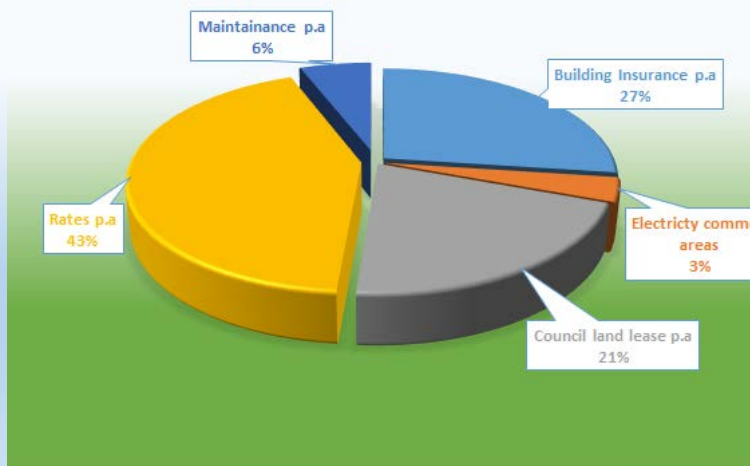
