Only 44 km from Perth CBD, with seamless connections via Marmion Avenue and the Mitchell Freeway.



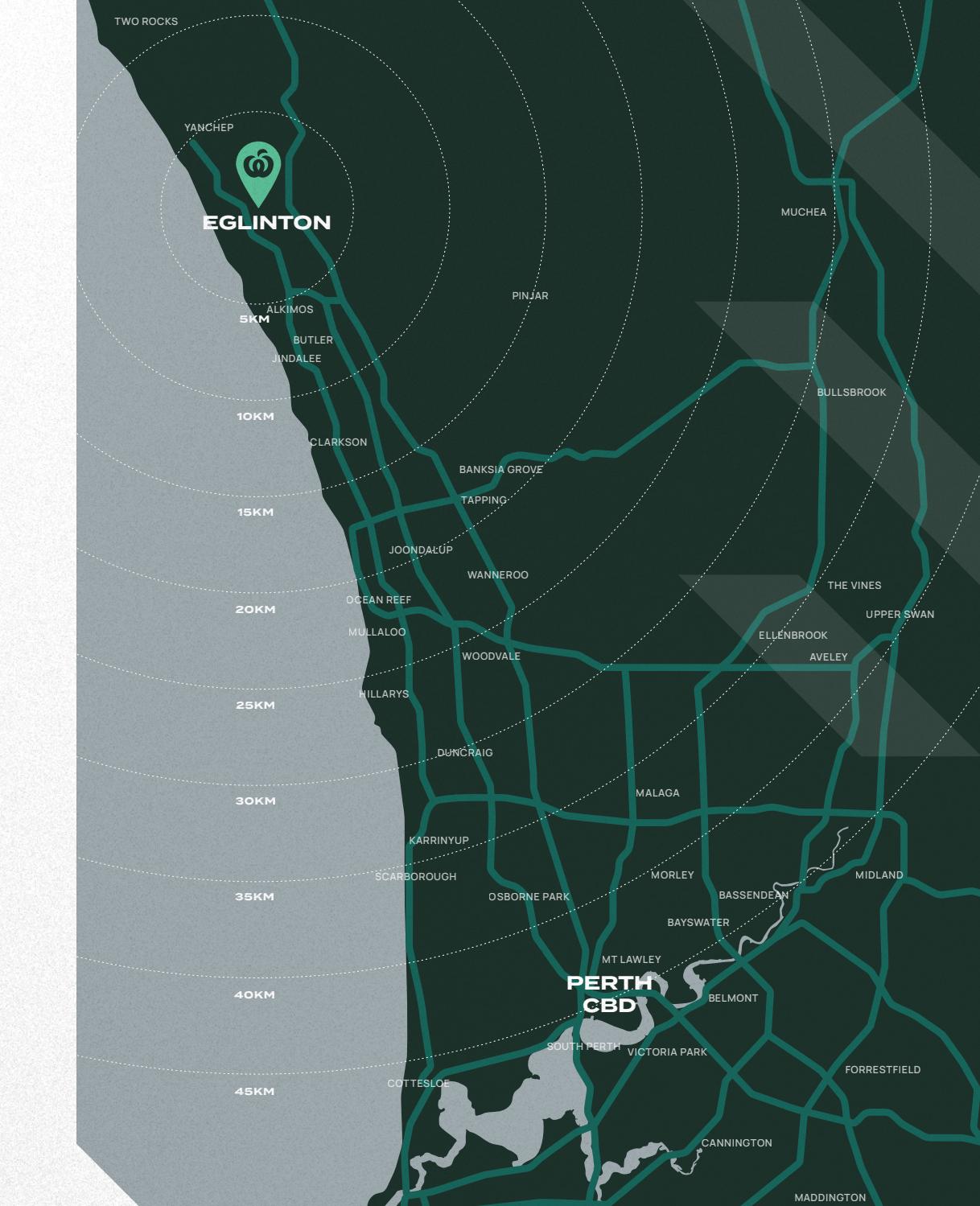

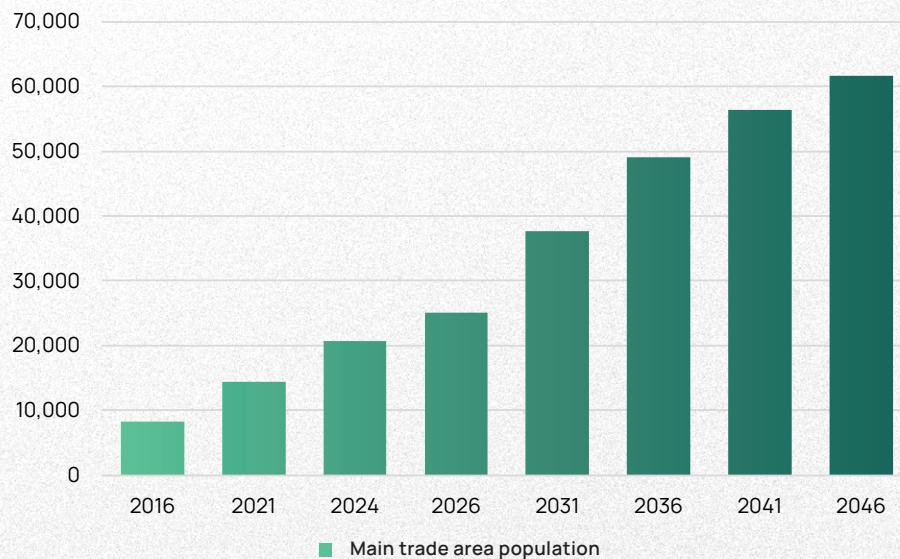

Eglinton's expanding population

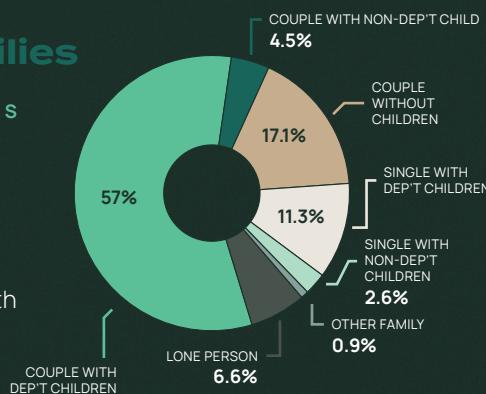
The Eglinton main trade area is home to a young, growing population that values convenience, lifestyle services, and community-focused amenities.

LOCAL HOUSEHOLDS

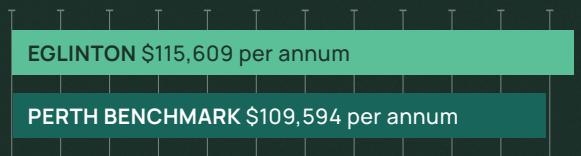
68.3% of households are families with dependent children, significantly higher than the Greater Perth average of 46.4%.
