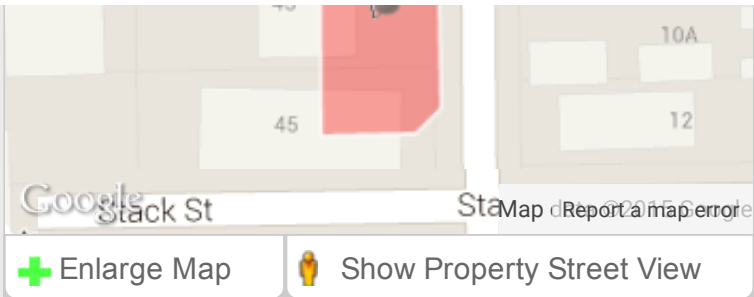

Lot 1219 (10) Stack Street was known until 1974 as 38 Fothergill Street. Plans between 1952 and 1955 show the site as vacant. In 1956 plans prepared by Fremantle Architects Allen and Nicholas were submitted by Lindsay Hudson Brown and approved by council.
